Do you generally want to receive a message?

So if you want to receive a message - I call it an ABC message or ABC message - ABC means AufBauCode - then take your book or a piece of paper, colored pens and ask: How many digits does the message have? There are usually three, four or five, sometimes more. Then ask each place whether it contains a letter, a number, a color, a symbol or a component from another system, such as a sequence of themes or the zodiac, for example. Most of the time, however, it doesn't go that far. For letters, you ask for upper and lower case, and for Greek. For the numbers, you ask whether they are the results of calculations and derive them accordingly. You can also use intermediate elements between the individual positions, usually small letters that serve as verbs to connect the individual nouns.

The abc-code as a dynamic system differs from conventional numerology. Current and personal questions will seldom find a precise answer there. The abc-code gives you an individual insight to your personal questions. Due to the infinite number of possibilities that result from the methodology in the abc-code, alien influence and doctrine are almost impossible. So there is an exciting new territory to enter! I wish every new user a lot of fun with the abc-code, deep insight and high fulfillment. Practice makes the master, as it is with everything. The abc-code is like a musical instrument. It takes a while until it sounds, and another wile until the sound also pleases. So stay tuned!


Decoding together





The abc-code is the other way around: The number you night have dreamed corresponds to the result and the calculation shall be reconstructed. With the yes/no method - and commuting is allowed - you ask until the right term is found: Is the number an addition or a subtraction, a multiplication or a division, a potency or a root ... ? Keep asking until the whole calculation is found. You come to a meaningful interpretation by noting the so found calculation vertically down so that on the left side remains some room for the basic meaning of the numbers. Ask to whom the message relates to and intuitively try to formulate a text that contains all the basic meanings and additions in turn. You will receive a - perhaps cryptic - text that makes sense to you personally.
